
- ➤ Yard Maintenance: Please pay special attention to where your water utility meters are located and try to keep the weeds and grasses clear around it. All grasses, noxious weeds, (as defined in Idaho Code section 22-2402) or other weeds need to stay under ten inches (10") tall. (Ord. 271, 7-1-2008) This will also aide in fire safety and just make the city prettier. Thanks ©
- ➤ Attention all Commercial Bulk Water Haulers The new Water Hauling station is up and running, it's located on the west side of N. Old Hwy 95 just past Farragut Bar and the Sonrise Daycare, next to the Kootenai Electric Substation. Contact City Hall to set up your account, passcode, and billing.
- ▶ Budget for FY 2024 is just getting under way Planning for a workshop this month. This is the Council's first review of the current fiscal year and beginning to look at the next fiscal year, identifying projects and goals for the upcoming year. The tentative Public Hearing date has been set for Tuesday, August 20th at 6:00pm; the public is welcome to attend and ask questions.
- ➤ City Staff has begun working with <u>Clearwater Financial</u> to identify various projects and the scope of work needed for things ranging from community surveys, RFP's, grant applications, long range planning services and other economic development services.
